## Pays d'Hérault *Indication Géographique Protégée*

*Product of France*

This blend is produced in the South of France, in the Languedoc.

The grapes are mostly from the base of the Black Mountains, North of Beziers. The vines are located on clay and limestone soils with high iron content; it is what gives the soil its characteristic red colour.

### Grape Variety

60% Carignan  
30% Grenache  
10% Merlot

### Vinification

The harvesting date is decided after an analysis and tasting of the grapes. The goal is to achieve full maturity while retaining freshness, softness and supple tannins.

### Winemaker comments

The colour of the wine is ruby red. You will enjoy a pleasant nose with hints of red fruits and spices. The palate is well rounded and balanced.

The wine is a good accompaniment to red and white meat or cheeses. Serve at 15C
