

Beaune 1er Cru "Aux Coucherias" 2020, Domaine Machard de Gramont

Produced from 63 year old vines, fermented and aged in 50% new Vosges oak, which gives added structure to the wine.

Tasting Notes:

The colour is dark, dense and appealing, with a nose of concentrated dark fruits, mulled in style, and offering notes of sweet black cherry streaked with mulberry, cassis and raspberry. Freshness supports the fruit core and oak perfectly. The oak is concentrated and layered into the fruit, adding spice, vanilla and a touch of tobacco and irons one. This is a big wine – full of energy, power and intensity.
