This is one of only three Bourgogne Pinot Noirs that can attach the vineyard name to its label. It has now been given the go ahead to be re-classified to the appellation of Marsannay. However, Alban very kindly continues to declassify this wine especially for us. What a lovely man!

Tasting Notes:

This is a wonderful Pinot Noir, very ripe, loaded with mulled black fruits, liquorice, cherry smoky spice. It has an open structure and a lovely sophisticated quality to both tannins and acidity. It is robust, yet elegant with a very long finish.

Vinification	Handpicked, crushed and fermented in tank before transfer to a mixture of 2-4 year old Hungarian and French oak, some of them with American oak ends (unique - but in a good way!). Aged for 6-8 months before marrying back in tank prior to bottling.
