This exotically fruity but dry wine, winner of a Gold Medal at the CGA 2025, is a tribute to the ancient local grape varieties, Les Vignes Retrouvées (“the rediscovered vines”) of the Pyrenean foothills. An exciting alternative to New World Sauvignon Blanc.

Tasting Notes:

Very pale straw-yellow robe with brilliant highlights. Its palate is ample and ripe, fresh, fruity, and particularly easy to digest.
